- Quick detachable bipod with spiked feet
- Monopod to reduce fatigue in operations of long duration.
- Rear Grips for use in inclement weather.
- No-tools removable carry handle
- Lightweight bolt carrier—reduces weight by .5kg (1 lb)
- Adjustable scope rings—allows fullest range of scope elevation adjustment.
- Removable muzzle brake to facilitate barrel replacement in the field
- New rear sight calibrated for military ammunition.
